John Farrell, Roads Supervisor  
Provided written report

Highlights

- Grading gravel roads
- Ditching along Wyman and Whalen Rds
- Grass cutting has commenced
- Cutting down high shoulders on Melrose
- Gravel and cold patching throughout Township

The Clerk added a few points:

- Dust control is being applied and more is scheduled to arrive this week
- The Clerk and Roads Supervisor have authorized approximately \$20,000 to deal with the most problematic stretch of the Deseronto Rd until discussions conclude with our MP and CN in regards to funding for this road's rehabilitation
- The cost will be split 50/50 with County of Lennox & Addington
- The Clerk on behalf of John asked if the 1km (east) resurfacing of Hinchey Rd be deferred until next year when we can do all 3km at the same time
- This extra 1km would be added to the Read (Cross to Shannon) southbound approximately half way between Shannon and Enright

THAT this Council amends our resurfacing work for 2011 whereby the 1km of Hinchey Rd scheduled for this year will not be done and instead an extra kilometer be added southbound for the work scheduled on the Read Rd from the 7<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Concessions. Be it further moved that it is Council's expectation that the entire length of Hinchey Rd be resurfaced in 2012.

- The Clerk and Reeve also advised Council that we would be meeting with our engineers and Quinte Conservation on Wednesday June 8<sup>th</sup> to discuss options for the culvert conversion on the Lang's bridge
- Our goal is to attain Quinte Conservation approval for the works at the least expense possible
