## **DELEGATIONS**

## **Brian King – Lafleshe Environmental**

- As the Township is a long term customer, Mr. King attended Council to keep Council abreast of new developments and innovations with the corporation
- Lafleshe is part of the TransForce family of companies
- Lafleshe is the waste company and Latrech is the hauler, both part of TransForce
- This is a one stop solution that can eliminate separate contracts for tripping and haulage
- They operate a transfer station in Russell and in 2012 acquired the old Rancor facility in Belleville
- The company promotes local hiring and training with a priority put on ethical behaviors for the whole company
- In the area of waste disposal, diversion from landfilling is the priority and do everything to ensure that all landfilled material cannot be otherwise diverted
- Lafleshe is pleased with their good community relations where we are a good example
- The company underwent large corporate changes in 2008 where the ownership structure changed
- The site based in Moose Creek is licensed for 755,000 tons per year
- They currently accept about 400,000 tons per year
- The site is 500 acres with land holdings of an additional 2000 acres in the immediate area
- All leachate is collected and treated
- The company is participating in many progressive green initiatives such as methane gas collection and solar
- Mr. King thanked Council for their long standing relationship and in turn Council thanked Lafleshe for the same

- The tractor has now complete its first cut throughout the Township roads and is starting the second cut
- We have done some grading on the gravel roads
- Most time has been spent with the Marysville Rd reconstruction project
