Pumpkin People Display: Is open to all ages, individuals, families, clubs, groups & businesses. Each person, family or group may only enter one time. Participants must have all Pumpkin People Displays ready for viewing no later than October 23rd, 2018. Pumpkin people display must be available for viewing from Wednesday October 24th, 2018 till Friday October 26th, 2018 Township of Tyendinaga reserves the right to refuse any Pumpkin people display deemed offensive or in poor taste.

Judging: Pumpkin People displays will be judged by our 5 Council Members. Pumpkin People will be judged on Difficulty, Originality, Creativity and Entertaining. The combined score of the 5 judges will determine 1st, 2nd, and 3rd winners.

Map: Upon final registration, the Township of Tyendinaga will provide a map indicating areas where Pumpkin People are Displayed. The Township of Tyendinaga encourages participants to promote their Pumpkin People display through their personal Facebook, Twitter, and other social media platforms.

Decorating Tips: Use plastic bags stuffed with newspaper, hay or other light weight materials to make the arms, legs and bodies. Supplies of duct tap, glue, plumbers foam, 2x4's, towels, nails, scissors, PVC pipe, wire, coat hangers and rope will help you when building your Pumpkin Person Display.

Once you're ready to assemble your display, the best way to secure the pumpkin head to a stake or post by cutting a small hole in the pumpkin base. If using a real pumpkin, leave the stuffing in the pumpkin. Put the stake/post through the small cut hole and fill entire inside of the pumpkin with plumbers foam. This will help keep the stake or pole in place and slow the rotting process of the pumpkin. Remember, pumpkins are heavy which is why it's recommended you use a 2x4's. Old mop heads, wigs and straw or other materials can be used for hair.

Wind can be a factor. It is important that you secure your displays tightly to the ground or anchor them to something.

Remember in order to enter the contest you must submit a registration and picture to Township office by October 23rd, 2018

Your display must be left up until Friday October 26th, 2018 for judging purposes.
