

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TYENDINAGA
BY-LAW NO. 2021-10

**BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT THE MULTI-YEAR ACCESSIBILITY PLAN AND
POLICIES FOR THE INTEGRATED ACCESSIBILITY STANDARDS REGULATION
(IASR) FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TYENDINAGA**

The Council of The Corporation of the Township of Tyendinaga enacts as follows:

WHEREAS the Ministry of Community and Social Services enacted the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 (AODA)* on June 13, 2005, as amended;

AND WHEREAS the purpose of the AODA is to make Ontario accessible through implementation and enforcement of regulated accessibility standards related to goods, services, facilities, employment, accommodation and buildings;

AND WHEREAS the first standards under the AODA are the Accessibility Standards for Customer Service, Ontario Regulation 429/07, as amended;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to adopt a policy for the Integrated Accessibility Standard Regulation (IASR 2011), as amended, for staff, Council, Committees, Boards and the public;

AND WHEREAS designated public sector organizations are required to comply with the standard January 1, 2010. This standard is the law and obligated organizations must comply with the requirements and report on compliance;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Tyendinaga does hereby adopt the "*Multi-Year Accessibility Plan and Policies*" attached hereto as Schedule "A";

AND THAT any other By-laws, schedules to By-Laws, resolutions or actions of Council that are inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law, are hereby repealed and rescinded and have no further force or effect.


