

Authority – By-Law 04-2022

Notwithstanding the provisions of section 4.1 of this by-law an individual who owns more than three (3) dogs, for the purpose of breeding, training or boarding for profit or not for profit shall apply and pay an annual licence fee to obtain a Kennel Licence from the township.

For the purposes of boarding and training kennel the dogs do not live at the property where they are to be boarded or trained on a permanent basis but will be at the kennel for more than 8 consecutive hours.

Checklist: General	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Kennel is in compliance with the Township’s Comprehensive Zoning By Law and is located within the Permanent Agriculture (PA) or Marginal Agriculture (MA) zones.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The kennel shall comply with the requirements set out in "A Code of Practice for Canadian Kennel Operations" Canadian Veterinary Medical Association, Third Edition, 2018.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The owner, operator or manager of the Kennel resides on the property on which the Kennel is located.

Check list: Kennel Conditions:	
<input type="checkbox"/>	The kennel building is a separate building and not attached to any building used or capable of being used for human habitation.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The kennel building and its location shall conform to the zoning by-law and the Ontario Building Code and the building shall be maintained in damage-free condition.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The kennel floor is made of concrete or other impermeable material, and has a drain opening constructed as a plumbing fixture.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Cages are adequately sized to allow the animal to extend its legs to their full extent, to stand, sit, turn around, or lie down in a fully extended position.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Cages are constructed solely of metal, or wire, or partly of wire, and have metal or other impermeable bottoms.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The kennel building has adequate lighting, ventilation.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The kennel building has hot and cold running water.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The kennel building a heating/cooling system sufficient to maintain sufficient temperature.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The kennel building has space for adequate water and feed.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Any outside area is surrounded with a chain link fence having a height of at least 2.6 metres (eight feet) the wall of an adjacent building may be included as part of such fenced-in area.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The premises shall be maintained in a sanitary, well ventilated, clean condition, naturally lighted, with a healthful temperature, free from vermin and disease and free from offensive odours.

The Animal Control Officer and any person designated may inspect any place where the dogs are kept, pursuant to this by-law.

If the kennel is found not to conform, to the requirements set out herein, the Animal Control Officer may direct that the animals be seized and impounded and may revoke the license issued.
